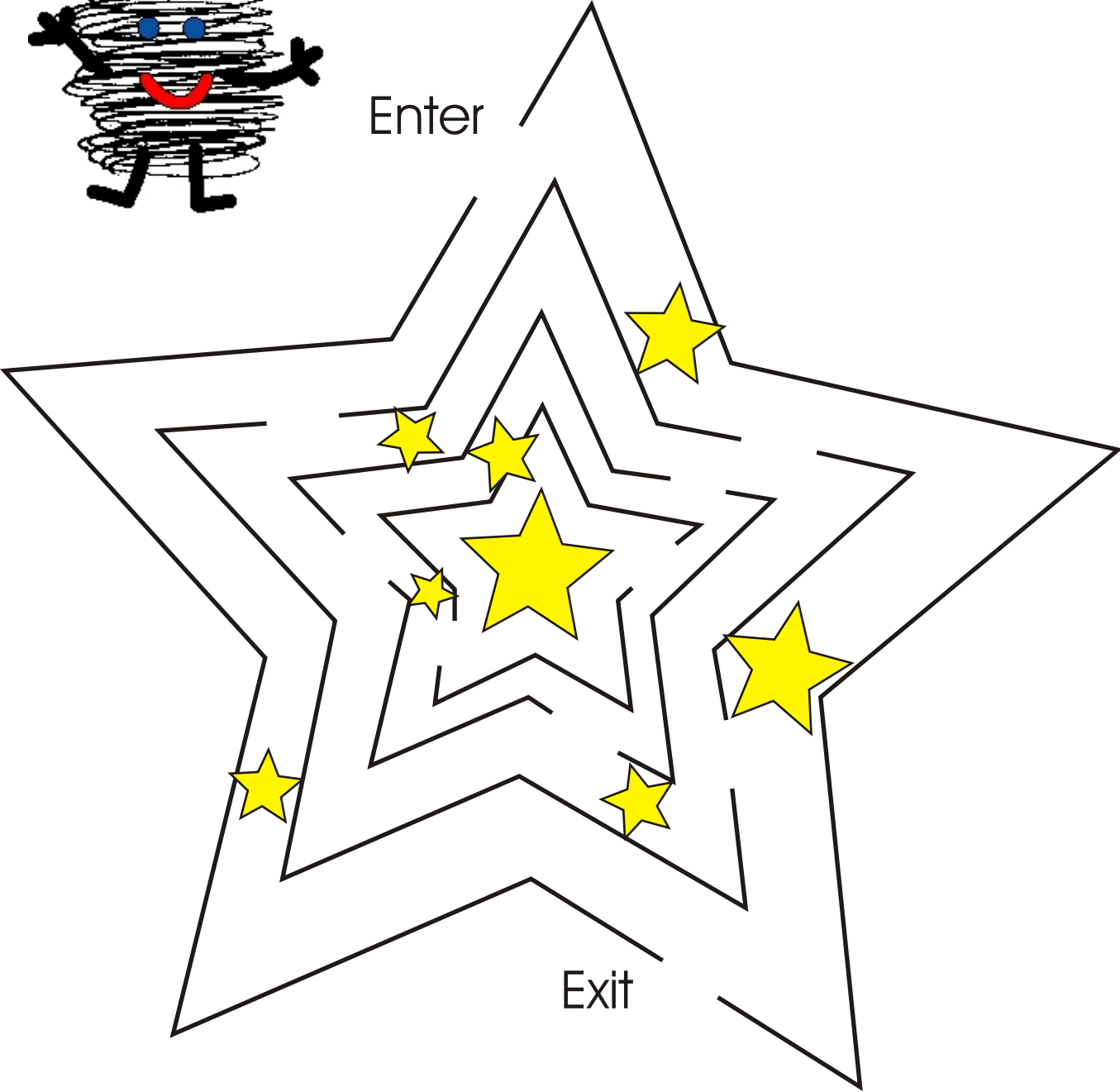

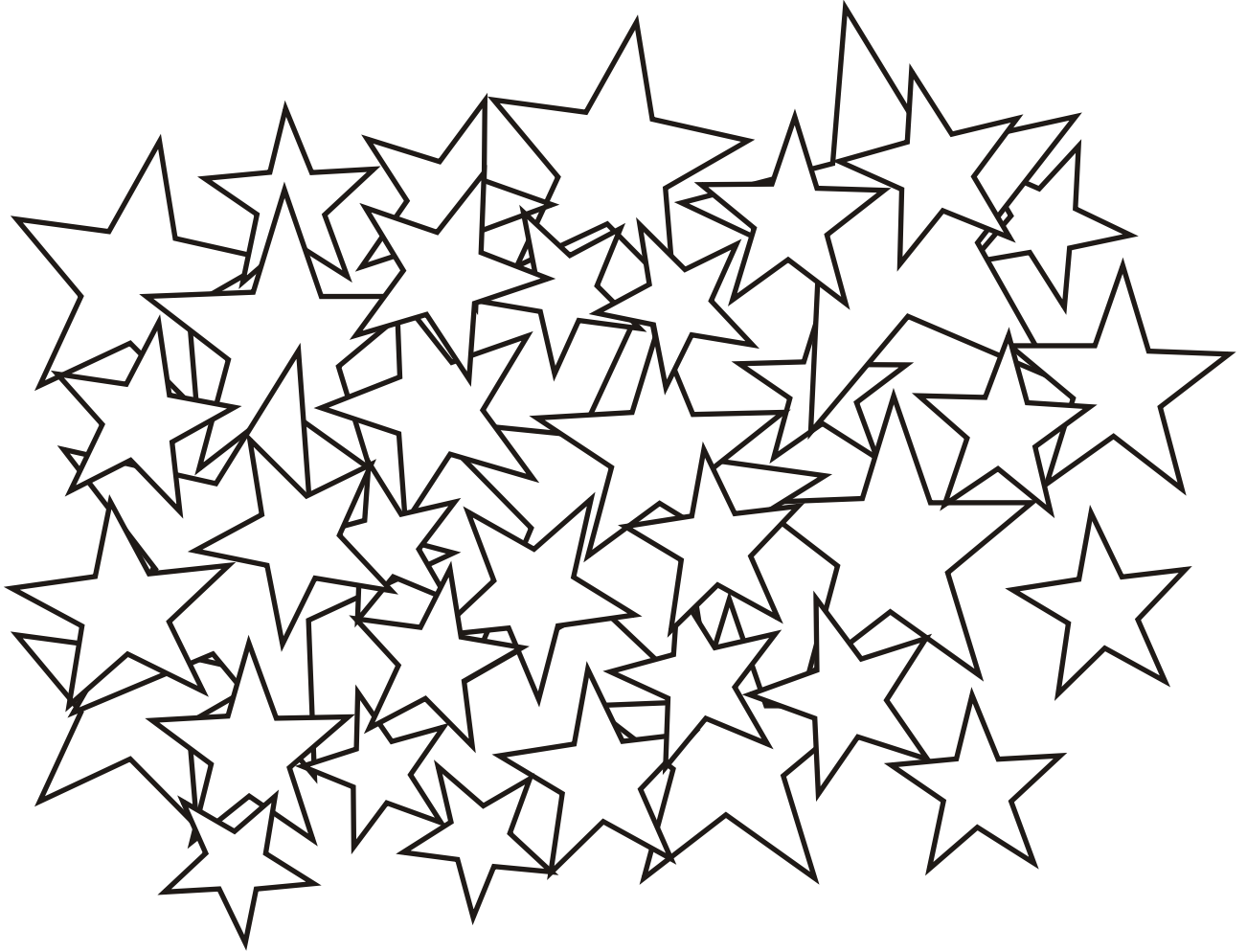

LOGIC PUZZLE

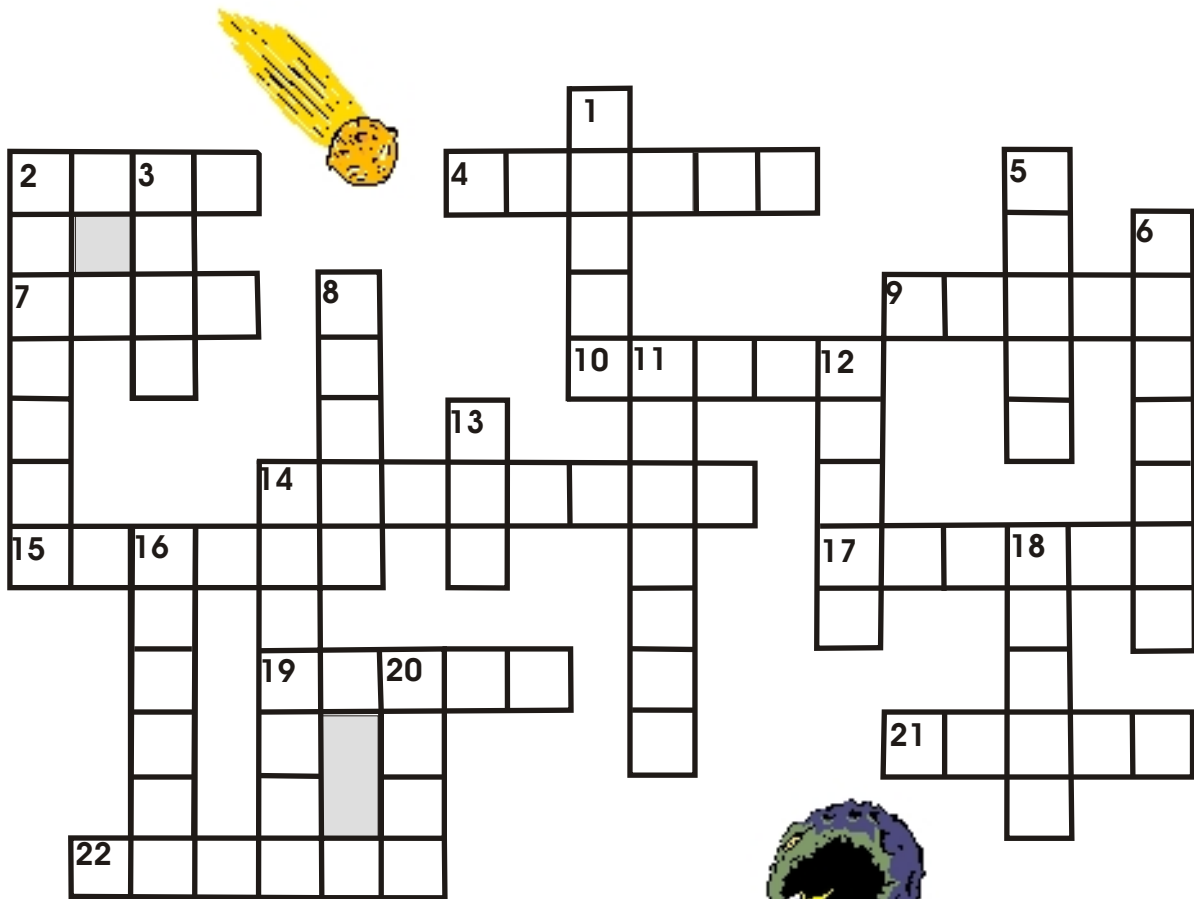

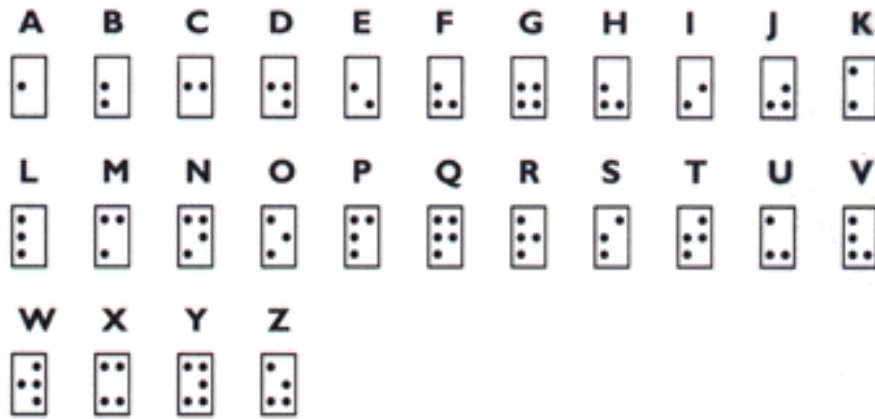
This code comes to us from Samuel Morse.

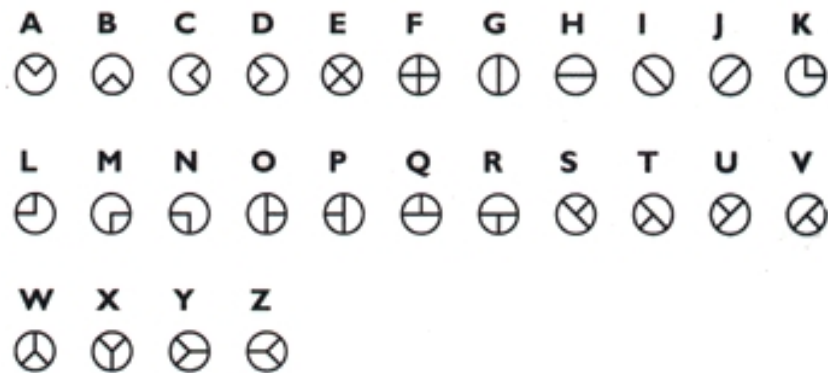
