**2. The Law of the Pack**  
 The Cub Scout follows Akela.

**Say the Law and tell what it means (Ah-KAY-la)**

**3. The Meaning of Webelos**

**4. The Cub Scout Sign**  
 First two fingers on your right hand and with your arm held straight up.  
 The two fingers stand for two parts of the Promise—"to help other people" and "to obey."  
 They look like a wolf's ears ready to listen to Akela. Give the Cub Scout sign when you say the Cub Scout Promise or the Law of the Pack.

**5. The Cub Scout Handshake**  
 Use your right hand just as you always do to shake hands. Put your first two fingers along the inside of the other boy's wrist. This means that you help and that you obey the Law of the Pack.

**6. The Cub Scout Motto**

**Say the Cub Scout motto and tell what it means**

**7. The Cub Scout Salute**  
 Salute with your right hand. Hold your fingers as you do the Cub Scout sign. Keep the two straight fingers close together. Touch the tips to either your cap or eyebrow. A salute is a way to show respect. We salute the flag to show respect to our county.
